- Now working with 23 out of 40 sites on onboarding process (scheduling meetings, setting up data flow, etc.)

- MVF and SC4S finalized ACURE4Moms Doula EHR
- Received data from Galations and 5 UNC sites to test Sheps data flow systems
  - Sheps team working on sending this test data to HIEA so data intervention tools can be tested
