Updates



Recruitment & Enrollment:

- 49 sites randomized
- 38 sites started Intervention with
- 18,187 patients enrolled
- 1 site pending intervention start

Longitudinal Patient Survey:

- 5,296 potentially eligible participants
- 1,742 assessed for eligibility as of 9/3/24
- 734 enrolled; 164 withdrawn
- Completed surveys:
- Survey #1: 509



Maternal Health Equity Education & Training (MHEET) Sessions: 92 total completed

- MHEET #1: 29 completed (8 observed)
- MHEET #2: 23 completed (9 observed)
- MHEET #3: 21 completed (10 observed)
- MHEET #4: 16 completed (9 observed)
- MHEET #5: 4 completed (1 observed)

Pre-Implementation Interviews:

- 131 staff completed preimplementation interviews (5 from practices that have dropped out)
- Recruiting 1 staff
- 119 transcripts coded
- Finalizing initial analysis of preimplementation interviews

- Recruiting 4 staff
