Since 2022, the ACURE4Moms study has made great strides towards increasing awareness of maternal health inequities across North Carolina. We are so proud of the dedicated team members who are making this important research study possible.

## **Updates**



Maternal Health Equity Education & Training (MHEET) Sessions: 159 total completed

- MHEET #1: 30 completed (8 observed)
- MHEET #2: 29 completed (9 observed)
- MHEET #3: 28 completed (11 observed)
- MHEET #4: 26 completed (11

#### **Recruitment & Enrollment:**

- 49 sites randomized
- 37 active sites
- 37,535 patients enrolled
- Wake Forest Baptist started 12/12/24
- Galatians stopped offering prenatal care as of 01/16/2025

### **Longitudinal Patient Survey:**

- 10,941 potentially eligible participants
- 4,150 assessed for eligibility
- 1,642 enrolled; 461 withdrawn
- Completed Survey #1: 1,129
- All CBRC are onboarded
- 21 CBRCs actively recruiting
- 17 CBRCs are now recruiting participants for 2 sites

#### **Doula Intervention:**

As of 02/28/25 MVF and MAAME have a combined # of 23 active doulas providing support to practices.

MVF doula support services as of 03/31/25:

#807 doula referrals (from 11 practices).

# 209 doula matched with clients.

#74 doula-supported births.

MAAME doula support services as of 04/30/25:

# 429 doula referrals (from 10 practices).

# 44 doula matched with clients.

# 59 doula-supported births.

- Receiving referrals from all active sites randomized for doula services.
- Brought on additional personnel and doulas to help manage referrals and clinical outreach.
- Working on a sustainability plan for doulas and practices.
- Identifying which practices they can continue/start doula intervention once 2-year implementation ends.

- Development of session 9 (final session) has begun.

#### **Pre-Implementation Interviews:**

- 136 staff completed preimplementation interviews
- All transcripts coded
- Finalizing initial analysis of pre-implementation interviews
- CMIH team has received constructive feedback from mid-point implementation interviews conducted to-date.
- Working to address feedback in real-time.
- Brought on Rakiah Anderdon to help with interviews.

#### **Mid-Point Interviews:**

- 74 staff completed mid-point implementation interviews
- Recruitment has started for two more practices.
- Next push for Mid-Point and Endpoint interviews anticipated for June 2025

#### **Aspirin Alert**


- Rolled out full alert 01/30/25
